Planting 39 – Naylor Road Woods/West Heinkel Unit – Fall 1999

This small wooded area was partially cleared and thinned of trees (elm, cherry, apple, buckthorn, etc.) in November and December of 1999. Trees were stump herbicided with the usual Garlon 4 in mineral oil.

Some area of the adjacent crop field was marked off for planting and will not be farmed again.

The entire area (portion of crop field adjacent and the cleared/thinned area of the woodland) was seeded by hand with appropriate prairie and savanna mixes in December before the rain and snow. This was all done by Jay Stacy and the West Heinkel Crew. Then the field area was raked with the tractor harrow.
